

It is time to register for NATIONAL RALLY DAY!

National Rally Day is a once in a lifetime chance to celebrate all things Guiding with Members from coast to coast on the same day!

All 11 locations in Alberta, NWT, and Yukon will deliver the same rally which will celebrate our rich history and the many aspects of Guiding in Canada and around the world.

The plan is to be OUTSIDE having fun together. Most locations have a rain out location for the opening and closing ceremonies. You'll get the full details, safe guide forms and kit lists in the registration packet.

The girls will participate with their Units with appropriate ratio of Guiders and Non-Members as needed. The activity stations will be set up with volunteers who are facilitating the session with the Unit Guiders helping to deliver the program. All the activity stations will have branch appropriate activities. You can attend as a district group of girls or multiple units together.

All transportation and food will be handled by the Units directly. The locations have identified sleepover and camping opportunities nearby that you can stay at as an Unit.

Special for Sparks - we will ensure the day is set up for our youngest branch to have a great experience, such as staggering their start time to keep the day a reasonable length. This will be specific to the location and the Spark Guiders will be contacted directly with more details following the close of registration.

Special for Pathfinders and Rangers - the local rally teams are working hard to develop unique activities only for you! This will be a combination of advanced service projects and scavenger hunts in the vicinity of the rallies. Following the close of registration we will be contacting the Pathfinder and Ranger units with the specific details.

For older girls working with younger units, the Unit Guider should register all the girls together but we will be in touch to see if the Pathfinder or Ranger would prefer to join their peers for the advanced activity.
