



## Growing in 2011

Now that the big 100 Year Anniversary is behind us, it doesn't mean that there aren't still celebrations and special events to take part in! WAGGGS is encouraging all of us to GROW in 2011 – GROW membership, GROW our knowledge, and GROW our involvement in our communities.

### Here are a few ideas to help you GROW in 2011

- **100 Photographs:** Photograph things which the letters, O-N-E H-U-N-D-R-E-D. Make the photos into a montage and send them to the WAGGGS Centenary Coordinator: [centenary@wagggsworld.org](mailto:centenary@wagggsworld.org) They will be posted on the WAGGGS website for the whole world to see!
- **Design a Bookmark:** Include the 2011 centenary theme of GROW in your bookmark. To make a bookmark you could cut out some card or fabric, and decorate or personalize it however you choose. You could even have the girls make two bookmarks – one for themselves and one for a friend – include information on how the friend can join Guiding on the back
- **Grow your Knowledge of WAGGGS:** Get to know something about 100 Member Organizations. Hold a Quiz about WAGGGS in your group, or get together with a younger group to help them learn about Girl Guides and Girl Scouts in another Country. Girls could also make a passport out of a notebook and get their passport stamped every time they learn about a new member country
- **Have a planting party** – Plant seeds at one of your meetings for the girls to take care of at home – grow a sunflower (something similar) and see if the girls can get it to grow to be 100cm
- **Grow a collection over 100 Days:** For example, start with one badge or pin and see if the Unit can collect 100 different badges or pins over 100 days. When the collection is complete see if you can display it somewhere for other Units to see
