

Pre-Trip Checklist

For Custodial Group Leaders Planning Winter Backcountry Travel in Avalanche Terrain

| Review topographical maps and guidebooks. Determine your destination. Check the national park web site for current information. Contact the park if you need more information or advice. |

| Ensure you do a thorough job of describing the trip and disclosing the risks to your organization, and to the parents of the minors in your group. This is extremely important. |
| Retain a certified mountain or ski guide. Visit <u>www.acmgguides.com</u> for more information. |
| Ensure your group is properly equipped, trained, and has suitable skills for the proposed trip. Your guide can assist with this. |
| Obtain a Custodial Group Permit Application Form from a national park visitor centre or the park's web site. |
| Outline the group composition and backcountry travel details. |
| Complete your application form and submit it. Note : the park must receive it at least two weeks prior to your trip start date. |
| Once approved, the permit will be sent to the group leader. |
